**TransCanada PipeLines Limited (TransCanada)  
2001 Interim Tolls Application to be effective 1 February 2001**

This is further to the National Energy Board's (the Board) letter dated 19 December 2000, in which the Board established a written process to decide on the appropriate level of TransCanada's interim tolls to be effective 1 February 2001.

The Board has considered TransCanada's Application for Interim Tolls dated 7 December 2000 and, as requested by the Board, confirmation of its application dated 21 December 2000.

As well, the Board has considered the responses to the Board's 19 December 2000 invitation to file comments from the Industrial Gas Users Association, Enbridge Consumers Gas, Union Gas Limited, the Canadian Association of Petroleum Producers, BP Canada Energy Company and Imperial Oil Resources in support of TransCanada's proposed interim tolls. The Board has also considered comments from the Ontario Non-Utility Generators (the Ontario NUG Group) and PG&E Energy Trading Canada Corporation/ El Paso Merchant Energy Canada in opposition to TransCanada's requested level of interim tolls. Finally, the Board considered the reply comments from TransCanada.

In considering an application for interim tolls, the Board does not make findings which amount to an adjudication on the issues to be dealt with in a subsequent toll proceeding. As the Board has stated in the past, a decision to approve interim tolls is, in no way, a ruling by this Board as to the merits of any case presented by TransCanada or by interested parties.

In setting interim tolls in this instance, the Board has had regard to the impacts of the level of these tolls on the pipeline company and the shippers. The Board is of the view that the proposed interim tolls reflect reasonable cost-based assumptions based on TransCanada's currently approved rate-making methodology. Accordingly, the Board has decided to approve TransCanada's proposed interim tolls effective 1 February 2001.

**ORDER AO-1-TGI-6-2000**

**IN THE MATTER OF THE** *National Energy Board Act* (the Act) and the regulations made thereunder;

**AND IN THE MATTER OF** an application filed with the National Energy Board (the Board) under File 4400-T001-21 by TransCanada PipeLines Limited (TransCanada) for certain orders respecting tolls specified in a tariff pursuant to Part IV, Sections 59, 60, 64 and 65 of the Act.

**AND IN THE MATTER OF** a written proceeding established by the Board on 19 December 2000 for the purpose of inviting comments on the appropriate level of interim tolls effective 1 February 2001.

**BEFORE** the Board on 25 January 2001.

**WHEREAS** TransCanada filed an application, dated 7 December 2000 and confirmed 21 December 2000, for an Order, fixing tolls it may charge, on an interim basis, for or in respect of transportation services rendered, effective 1 February 2001;

**AND WHEREAS** the Board has considered comments from interested parties on the appropriate level of interim tolls to be effective 1 February 2001;

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED**, pursuant to section 21 of the Act, that:

1. Pursuant to Part IV of the Act, that TransCanada's current interim tolls which were made effective under Toll Order TGI-6-2000 be terminated as of the end of the day on 31 January 2001.
2. TransCanada's proposed tolls, as contained in its Application dated 7 December 2000 and confirmed on 21 December 2000, be implemented effective 1 February 2001 on an interim basis pending a final order by the Board concerning TransCanada's 2001 tolls.
