

Question 2 :

This question pertains to Delivery Point and Transmission Service. Why limiting the "HQT" Delivery Point to HQP only? It is discriminatory to other market participants. It then puts HQP on a different playing field than the other participants as HQP will be the only one able to choose for any Delivery Points in real-time. In opposition, the other market participants will have to negotiate for an alternate delivery point with HQD on a daily basis, without any guarantee that HQD will accept it. In opposition, HQP, with its HQT delivery point, will be able to go wherever it wants without any limitations or additional costs imposed by HQD. Why HQD doesn't let everybody choose the HQT delivery point if desired, with the associate transmission risk on the buyer's side? Any market participant that wants to have HQD supplying the Transmission Services as proposed in the CFT document for the others Delivery Points would just have to choose a Delivery Points other than "HQT".

Answer 2 :

The transmission path referred to in the question is not a path available in Québec for parties outside TransÉnergie's system. Hydro-Québec TransÉnergie has indicated that no request for such transmission service has ever been made in the past.
