

APPLICATION FOR INTERVENTION

**IN SUPPORT OF ITS PRESENT APPLICATION FOR INTERVENTION
PURSUANT TO RULES 5 AND 8 OF THE REGULATION RESPECTING THE
PROCEDURE OF THE RÉGIE DE L'ÉNERGIE, THE INTERVENOR HEREBY
STATES:**

1. Ontario Power Generation Inc. (hereinafter "OPG") is an Ontario corporation which owns and operates a significant portfolio of electricity generation plants in the Province of Ontario;
2. OPG hereby requests intervenor status from the Régie de l'énergie in the above referenced matter. OPG acknowledges that the proceeding is already underway, and makes this request specifically with respect to the remaining portion of the proceeding dealing with FERC-related tariff modifications;
3. OPG agrees to participate in such a way as to respect all previous decisions and to make any representations only on the subject matter of tariff modifications; therefore, if granted, OPG's intervention will not have any impact on the expediency or fairness of the hearing;
4. OPG buys and sells electricity from and into the interconnected markets of other provinces, including Québec, and the U.S. Northeast and Midwest and is, hence directly interested in the aspects of the proceeding dealing with potential Transmission Tariff revisions;
5. OPG believes that the issues raised in the present proceedings could affect the market conditions prevailing within Québec;

6. As a participant in the Québec electricity market, OPG has a legal and economic interest in this case;
7. As stated by the Régie in its decision D-2008-116 of September 11, 2008 in the present file, the evidence submitted by Hydro-Québec related to the conformity of the proposed modifications to the Transmission Tariffs and Service Conditions with the FERC Orders 890 and 890A is insufficient and the Régie will communicate subsequently with the participants to determine the most appropriate procedure for the treatment of this subject; moreover, the Régie has not yet rendered its decision on the application by Hydro-Québec for the modification of the Rates and Conditions for the Transmission of Electric Power in the present file;
8. Consequently, OPG cannot fully state, under Rule 6 of the Regulation respecting the Procedure of the Régie de l'énergie, the conclusions sought or recommendations proposed, neither the manner in which OPG will present its position, whether witnesses are to be heard or expert evidence presented nor an estimated hearing time but reserves all its rights to present such evidence, conclusions or recommendations;
9. OPG does not intend to ask for the reimbursement of its costs.


OPG THEREFORE PRAYS THE RÉGIE:
