Dear Me Dubois:

1. OPG appreciates the opportunity to respond to the comments filed by Hydro-Quebec (HQ) on March 4, 2009. OPG does so consistent with the schedule laid out in the Regie's February 12, 2009 Procedural Order.
2. In its submission, HQ suggests that OPG's request for intervention (dated February 20, 2009) did not identify the specific matters that are of interest to OPG. OPG respectfully disagrees with this submission.
3. Consistent with the Regie's February 12, 2009 Procedural Order, and the Regulation Respecting the Procedure of the Regie de L'Energie, on February 20, 2009, OPG filed a request for intervention indicating that OPG reserves the right to participate in matters that are relevant to OPG's business interests.
4. Specifically, OPG identified its interest in any Open Access Transmission Tariff issues that are associated with Orders 890 and 890A as issued by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission

(FERC). This is consistent with the Regie's Decision D-2008-116 dated September 11, 2008 and its Decision D-2009-015 dated March 5, 2009.

5. OPG notes from the Regie's February 12, 2009 Procedural Order that HQ is required to file additional evidence on March 12, 2009 regarding FERC related issues. OPG expects that HQ's submission will further clarify FERC issues and inform OPG's intervention.
6. Further, as indicated in the Regie's Decision D-2009-015 dated March 5, 2009, issues associated with Schedules 4 and 5 of HQ's Application will be addressed in Phase 2 of the proceeding.
7. As indicated in OPG's December 3, 2008 submission to the Regie on this topic, OPG has a significant and material interest in this matter, and submits that its intervention is appropriate and should be granted.

Accordingly, OPG reiterates its request for intervenor status and submits that HQ's objection is without merit and should be rejected by the Regie.
