

In 2012, customers with smart meters installed will have access to a secure, online account that will help them more closely monitor their electricity use

Accurate data and billing, plus the ability to monitor and reduce energy use

- · Hourly consumption information in kilowatt hours (kWh) and in dollars up to the last 24 hours
- · Estimated energy cost projections based on actual consumption patterns; and,
- · Optional automatic updates when you're nearing your targets.

As safe as your online banking account

The experience will be as safe and as simple as signing onto your online banking account to track your monthly savings and pay your bills.

Tracking energy use will help you understand how energy use affects your costs and enable you to take appropriate actions to save energy and save money.

You'll have access to the secure online account starting in mid-2012.

Beginning in 2013, you'll also have the option of adopting devices and software solutions to access your near real-time energy consumption information directly from your smart meter.
