we just fought off a planned industrial wind station
that was to be implanted in our village.

We successfully had that plan rejected both by BAPE
and by the gouvernement because the whole re-
gion stood up to say no.

It stood up to say that the station would be
dangerous to our health and that of our children,
it would devalue our property, it would
destroy prime agricultural land and it would
be nefarious for migrating birds and for
endangered bird and plant species.

This plan was socially unacceptable!

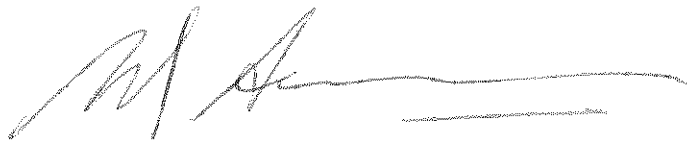
You are now called upon by the distribution
arm of Hydro-Québec to approve plans to con-
nect a proposed industrial wind station in Saint-
Cyprien, a bordering village of St-Valentin.

Again we are standing up against the Saint-
Cyprien project, for exactly the same reasons
we fought the St-Valentin project: in short
it is totally unacceptable from a social point
of view.

Why waste time and money on a project that has no future. Dismiss it right away, so everybody will be done with it and can go on with normal business.

The least your Regie could do is to put the study of the Saint-Cyprien project on hold until the judges settle the matter.
