Dear participants,

In its decision D-2021-003, the Régie de l'énergie (the Régie) stated that the hearings in the abovementioned file would start June 14, 2021.

The Régie hereby informs participants that the hearings will instead start on **June 15 at 9 a.m. and conclude June 17**. If more time is needed for the presentation of the case and cross-examination of the Énergir witnesses, **the Régie reserves June 18, 2021**, to complete the hearings.

The hearing will open to participants at 8:30 a.m. to allow for equipment checks.

As the Régie introduces the Teams platforms with small breakout spaces, the clerk of the hearings will require additional time during the first day of the hearings to manage the use of these spaces. For this the Régie is asking participants to **log in 30 minutes before the hearings start if they wish to use the breakout spaces**. Participants not arriving in sufficient time will need to wait for the next pause to enter a virtual breakout room.

To respect public health regulations and the recent CNESST publication on workspace safety [Mesures de contrôle dans les milieux de travail en contexte d'apparition de variants sous surveillance rehaussée](#), lawyers and witnesses are asked to take off their masks when they speak at the hearing, to ensure clear communication. It remains the responsibility of all participants to ensure appropriate physical distancing and take the measures requested to comply with the applicable standards.

The Régie reminds participants that they must respect the directives in the [Guide des participants externes à une audience à la Régie \(Microsoft Teams\)](#) and consult the

[Guide technique pour les participants aux audiences de la Régie \(Microsoft Teams\)](#) to help prepare their intervention.

You will find enclosed the schedule for the hearings, based on the information provided by the participants. The Régie has considered various constraints of participants to establish this schedule. It has also considered the requests noted below in this letter and provided for a longer period for the Distributor's main case.

The Régie will first hear the Énergir witnesses. Following this the expert from Elenchus will be available for questions from the participants and the Régie. The hearings will continue with oral presentations by ACIG and the FCEI, and wrap up with final arguments. To facilitate its work, the Régie asks participants to submit their notes when they begin their interventions.

The Régie encourages participants to keep their oral presentations of their written submission focused on highlighting key points and conclusions. We hope that participants will be flexible when connection or other videoconference issues arise.

In planning the hearings, the Régie has left open the possibility of Énergir requesting to submit a rebuttal. **In such a case, the Régie will hear the rebuttal Thursday, June 17 and the final arguments will be postponed to Friday, June 18, 2021.**
