Madame Dubois,

I refuse a smart meter based on the negative health impact of the transmitting devices (WHO grade 2B carcinogen). The smart meters proposed by HQ are also equipped with technology that is capable of wireless transmission of collected data, and in my opinion may actually compromise our right of privacy and pose security risk to our home.

In the event that a replacement meter is obligatory, we have asked that the new meter be analog, and that the installation, maintenance, and/or replacement incur no additional fees to us.

I am aware that you have within your inventory 294000 meters composed of 112500 electronic meters and 181500 electromechanical/analog meters. These must be salvaged and should be distributed to those clients, who like myself have duly requested them in order to maintain electrical delivery without the risks imposed from smart meters.
